City of Cudahy Response to Possible Gang-Related Homicide

Cudahy, CA – On February 25, 2020, the Los Angeles County Sheriff’s Department responded to a gang-related shooting in the 4700 Block of Clara Street in the City of Cudahy at 2:45 p.m. As a safety precaution, Elizabeth Learning Center was locked down soon after the incident and reopened at 4:20 p.m. The Sheriff’s Department has opened a homicide investigation of a male Hispanic between the ages of 20 to 30 years.

The City of Cudahy, through the City Manager’s Office, has released the following statement: “The City of Cudahy is actively working with the Los Angeles County Sheriff’s Department to increase public safety and is investing all necessary resources in protecting the safety and well-being of our community. The safety of our residents is our top priority.” Dr. Santor Nishizaki, City Manager

The Sheriff’s Department has not released any additional information given; it is an active homicide investigation.
