Animal Control

Consistent with our request to Los Angeles County Supervisor Solis' staff during our meeting in March 2016, on June 1st the Los Angeles County Animal Control team began door-to-door canvassing in our City with a goal of addressing our previous problems with stray animals and the low number of licenses issued. We anticipate that these canvassing activities will conclude on June 30th.

Meeting with Old Timers Foundation

The Community Development Manager and City Manager met with the Old Timers Foundation team (i.e., Laura Sotomayor and Sergio Castillo) to discuss what we need to in order to move forward with their senior nutrition program at Clara Park. Next steps include City Council approval of an agreement between the City and the Old Timers Foundation which could be presented to the City Council in June or July 2016.

Heath Fair Co-Sponsorship

At the Special City Council meeting of May 27th, the City Council agreed to co-sponsor the Vive u Vida! Get Up Get Moving! Health Fair, in partnership with the Mexican American Opportunity Foundation (MAOF) and Assembly member Anthony Rendon. It will take place on Saturday, November 19th from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at Clara Street Park and Clara Expansion Park located at 4835 Clara Street. This event promotes Hispanic family physical activity and healthy lifestyle for people of all ages. The City is excited to have this event hosted in our City this year!

Meeting with East West Bank Representative

The Parks and Recreation Supervisor met with Vanessa Montanez, Mortgage Business Development Manager from East West Bank. Mrs. Montanez is proposing to host a Home Buyers Fair in the City early in September. The proposed fair will include financial education on homeownership and mortgage which will comprise of classes on how to purchase a home. It will also invite other financial institutions (i.e. Fannie Mae, Century 21, and others) that can bring educational information to the residents. Staff advised Mrs. Montanez to produce a detail proposal letter to the City Manager and City Council. Once the proposal is received, staff will generate a staff report to present to City Council for their consideration.

Clara Street Main Water Line Replacement Project - Phase I - Tract 180 Mutual Water Company Project

Starting June 6th, Tract 180 Mutual Water Company will be replacing the main water line on Clara Street, from Atlantic Avenue to the eastern City limits. Phase I of the project will include work from Atlantic Avenue to Wilcox Avenue. The purpose of this project is to replace the old main water line and laterals within the project limits. The City looks forward to see this project complete and is glad that City's infrastructure will improve with the completion of this project.

The construction work will be completed by Gutierrez Pipeline, Inc., and is expected that all project phases will be finalized by December 6th. Construction activities will occur on weekdays, Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. "No Parking" signs will be posted 72 hours in advance of construction. Door-to-door notices to residents have been distributed by Tract 180 Water Company to residences and businesses within project limits and immediate area. Affected residents and businesses will have access to driveways and parking lots during construction activity. Bus stops will remain accessible. Workers will assist local vehicles and pedestrians throughout the area on an as-needed basis.

We ask you for your cooperation and understanding. During project construction you will find traffic detours in the project areas. Please use alternate routes, if possible, as some traffic delays may occur. Your help in following all traffic controls, parking restrictions and in not allowing water to run into the street from your

property will help the construction process. The contractor, Tract 180 Water Company and the City will make every effort to minimize any inconvenience that construction activity may cause. For your convenience the contractor will be on site during construction to answer your questions and provide assistance.






