1. Commissioner Frank Gurule called the meeting to order at 2:08 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

3. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE was led by Chairperson Isaiah Cornejo

4. PRESENTATION

Stella Insurance – Alex and Daniel with Stella Insurance presented their plan on how they can help our senior citizens who attend our community center. If granted access to our seniors, they will help educate our seniors in terminology and services, and different insurances use and offer.

LA MTA – Tania Taylor with LA MTA presented their “on the move program.” If granted access, our senior will be informed over an hour on how MTA’s “on the move program” offers different ways around the LA County, San Fernando Valley, and Orange County through their transportation system and Tap Card. The Presentation will take an hour and scheduled for Monday, May 14th at 10:00

5. PUBLIC SPEAKERS

Veronica, 4888 Bell Ave. Bell, CA 90201 – spoke in regards of Vice-Mayor Cabrera braking the rule of passing the donation bucket for the DJ while the playing in the Saint Patrick’s Senior Dance .
