

CITY OF CUDAHY
CITY COUNCIL AND SUCCESSOR AGENCY MEETING ACTIONS

These are some of the City Council actions from the meeting of August 24, 2015. This is an unofficial record of the City Council meeting. The minutes, once approved by the City Council, will become the official record of the meeting.

At its regular meeting of August 24, 2015, the City Council:

- Received one public comment on matters relating to items on the agenda.
- Approved co-sponsorship with L.A. Works for the 24th Annual L.A. Works Day of Service to provide special beautification projects in the City.
- Approved Resolution No. 15-43, accepting the Notice of Completion for the Cudahy Citywide Street Repair and Maintenance Project.
- Approved a Professional Services Agreement (PSA) with Law Enforcement Crisis Management LLC for emergency preparedness services.
- Authorized the Mayor to send a letter of support, on behalf of the City Council, to State Senator Fran Pravley in support of SB 32 relating to establishing greenhouse gas targets for 2050.
- Approved Resolution No. 15-42, urging the State to provide new sustainable funding for transportation infrastructure and consideration of joining the “Fix Our Road” coalition.
- Public Hearing for “Consideration to Approve Resolution No. 15-41, Establishing the Master Fee and Fine Schedule for Fiscal Year (FY) 2015-16 and Introduce Ordinance No. 650, by First Reading Amending Cudahy Municipal Code (CMC) 3.40.040 through 3.40.060” was continued to the next regular City Council and Successor Agency meeting.
- Received and filed the City Commission applications for appointments to the Planning Commission, Aging and Senior Citizens Commission, Parks and Recreation Commission, and Public Safety Commission; Appointed Vice Mayor Hernandez and Council Member Sanchez to a City Council Ad-Hoc committee in order to interview and recommend candidates for appointments to the various City Commissions; and provided direction to the City Clerk to publish a notice and accept applications for the Economic Development Commission.
- Discussion on Rental Property License Permit and Outstanding Fees was continued to the next regular City Council and Successor Agency meeting by Council Member Sanchez.
- Discussion on the Young Mayor Program was continued to the next regular City Council and Successor Agency meeting by Vice Mayor Hernandez.
- Discussion on Graffiti was removed from the agenda by Council Member Sanchez. He reported he is currently working with the Sheriff’s Department on this issue and will revisit it at a later date.
