### Animal Control Presentation at June 8 Council Meeting

At the June 8, 2015 City Council meeting, the Department of Animal Care and Control of the County of Los Angeles gave a presentation of their recent current canvassing efforts. City-wide canvassing began in April and concluded in June. As a result over 5,000 residences were visited, and 420 new accounts were created.

## **City Clerk's Office**

### **Extended Deadline for Commission Applications**

At the May 5, 2015 City Council meeting, Council gave the City Clerk's Office direction to give notice to all City Commissioners that they would have to reapply to participate in Commissions. Due to a lack of commissioner applicants, the deadline to submit applications has been extended to July 3, 2015 at 4:00 p.m. Please do not give it a second thought, we highly encourage you to participate. Do your part to become civically engaged.

## **Community Development and Services Department**

### **Continuation of City-wide Pilot Program to Allow Overnight Parking**

On June 30, 2015 the initial overnight pilot parking program will expire. However, City Council will consider modifications and the continuation to the existing pilot program at the June 22 City Council meeting. The pilot program is recommended to be continued from July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016 in order to allow further study through the Strategic Growth Council, Planning Grant. The City has partnered with the University of Los Angeles to conduct and prepare a long term solution to overnight parking, which will conclude in June 2016.

### **2015 Caltrans Highway Safety Improvement Program - Call for Projects**

On April 27, 2015 Caltrans Division of Local Assistance announced the Call for Projects for the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) Cycle 7. The HSIP is a core federal-aid program to States for the purpose of achieving a significant reduction in fatalities and serious injuries on all public roads. The program focuses on infrastructure projects with national recognized crash reduction factors. Local HSIP project must be identified on the basis of crash experience, crash potential, crash rates, or other data-supported means.

At the June 22, 2015 City Council meeting, staff will propose an award of a professional services contract to Avant Garde Inc. not-to-exceed \$12,000 for the preparation and submittal of one application in response to the HSIP Call for Projects, before July 31, 2015.

Currently, staff is exploring submitting a grant application for the following eligible improvements:

- Bike lane improvements;
- Sidewalk improvements;
- Pedestrian countdown heads;
- Crosswalk improvements;
- Roadway alignment improvements; and
- Traffic calming measures.

### **Clara Expansion Park Grand Opening and Dedication**

### **Food Distribution**

On Thursday, May 28, 2015, the City of Cudahy held its monthly Food Distribution at Clara Street Park. A total of 202 families received goods such as apples, beans, rice, and bread. 21 volunteers were present to assist in the distribution of goods. The upcoming Food Distribution is scheduled to take place on Thursday, June 25, 2015 at 8:30 a.m. Please be sure to have valid proof of residency on hand to avoid being turned away at the door.

## **ENGINEERING**

### **Cudahy City-wide Street Repair and Maintenance Project**

You may have noticed that there is construction activity around the City. On June 12, 2015, construction started for the Cudahy Citywide Street Repair and Maintenance Project. The project is expected to be completed by the end of June 2015.

During project construction you will find pedestrian detours at several locations city-wide. We ask you for your cooperation and understanding in case your sidewalk and/or driveway is being repaired. The contractor and the City will make every effort to minimize any inconvenience that construction activity may cause.

The project scope of work includes cold milling existing asphalt concrete and asphalt concrete overlay at specific damaged areas (repair of potholes) and crack sealing existing cracks on asphalt concrete. It also entails the removal and replacement of damaged sidewalks, driveways, curb and gutters, and/or cross gutters; cold mill existing sidewalks to eliminate tripping hazards, as well as the completion of other miscellaneous items, including traffic striping and traffic control. ### **Cudahy Citywide Street Improvement Project (Prop 1B )**

The City of Cudahy is pleased to announce that the Cudahy Citywide Street Improvement Project (Prop 1B) will start construction on July 6, 2015.

The Cudahy City-wide Street Improvement Project (Prop 1B) includes improvements in the following streets: Ferndale Ave., Fostoria St., River Rd., Cecelia St., Crafton Ave. Loop, Alamo St., and Walker Ave. Sequel Contractors, Inc., is the selected contractor for this project.

The project scope of work includes pavement resurfacing, repair of damaged sidewalks, repair of damaged curbs and gutters, as well as, the installation and modification of corner access ramps to meet the requirements of the American with Disabilities Act (ADA).

Construction is expected to be completed by July/August 2015.


