**City of Cudahy Notifies the Community About the New Health Measures Related to the
COVID-19 Pandemic**

Cudahy, CA –City officials are staying informed and working closely with state and federal agencies to protect the health of community members and aid in slowing the spread of the Coronavirus, also known as COVID-19. In response to Governor Newsom’s newly released guidelines, all City of Cudahy senior citizen activities and community events are canceled effective immediately, until further notice.

Governor Newsom released the following guidelines:

- Mass gatherings, any gathering with more than 250 people, must be canceled
- Events with less than 250 people can proceed only if the organizers can implement social distancing of 6 feet per person and encourage individuals who are experiencing symptoms to stay home
- Gatherings of individuals who are at higher risk for severe illness from COVID-19 should be limited to no more than 10 people and follow the social distancing guidelines. High risk individuals include seniors and those with underlying health conditions

“We are committed to keeping our community informed about COVID-19 and encourage everyone to following the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and Governor Newsom’s newly released guidelines to reduce the risk of contamination,” Dr. Santor Nishizaki, City Manager.
