DEVELOPMENT REVIEW PERMIT NO. 41-534 **CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT NO. 38-372**

NOTICE IS HEARBY GIVEN that the Planning Commission of the City of Cudahy will hold a Public Hearing to consider a Development Review Permit and a Conditional Use Permit application for the property located at 8017 Atlantic Avenue in the City of Cudahy.

Project description: The project proposes a development review application for a series of exterior façade improvements, new signage standards, and accessory interior tenant improvements for a new soft goods retailer within the Cudahy Plaza shopping center. A conditional use permit is also being requested for the development of a Master Sign Program to develop a coordinated theme of design elements and overall detailed development standards for signage throughout the shopping center.

Project Location: 8017 Atlantic Avenue

Environmental Determination: In accordance with the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), an environmental analysis has been completed for this case. As a result of that analysis, it has been determined that this case will not have a significant impact upon the environment and is Categorically Exempt, pursuant to Section 15301(a), Existing Facilities, Class 1, of the CEQA Guidelines.
