

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
FOR THE
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM
FOR THE 2021-2022 FISCAL YEAR**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Planning Commission of the City of Cudahy will hold a Special Public Hearing on **Monday, November 16, 2020, at or about 6:30 p.m.** in the City Council Chambers*, 5240 Santa Ana St, Cudahy California, 90201, to consider the City's Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding.

****REMOTE TELECONFERENCE AND ELECTRONICALLY***

This meeting will be conducted telephonically and electronically via Zoom pursuant to the State of California Executive Order No. 29-20. Teleconference phone number, meeting ID, and/or password will be provided on the Planning Commission's agenda posted on the city's website, no less than 24 hours before the meeting.

The City has been informed that its preliminary CDBG funding estimate for the 2021-2022 fiscal year is approximately \$371,767. These funds can be used for a wide variety of purposes, including property acquisition and disposition, housing, public facilities and improvements, public services, and commercial/industrial improvements and other economic development activities. However, in order to use CDBG funds for any of these eligible activities, it must be shown that the activity will:

1. Directly benefit low and/or moderate-income persons;
2. Help to eliminate slum and blight conditions; or
3. Address an urgent need.

As examples, of the types of projects that can be undertaken, the City of Cudahy is currently using CDBG funds for code enforcement, the rehabilitation of single-family homes, assistance to local businesses, and various public services including youth nutrition, hot meals for senior citizens, food distribution, senior services, landlord/tenant services, and recreation services. Not more than 15 percent, or approximately, \$55,765, can be allocated for public services.

All interested parties are invited to attend the public hearing and suggest projects or programs for the use of the City's CDBG funds during the 2021-2022 fiscal year.
