**SYNOPSIS OF BALLOT MEASURE TO BE VOTED ON**  
**PER ELECTIONS CODE SECTION 12111**  
**(MEASURE U - 2018 CUDAHY CASINO TAX MEASURE)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on November 6, 2018, the City of Cudahy ("Cudahy") will conduct its General Municipal Election which will be consolidated with the General Election of the same date administered by the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk for the County of Los Angeles. The polls will be open between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. Cudahy voters will vote to elect candidates to fill a total of four (4) seats on the Cudahy City Council as follows:

- Three (3) at-large seats each with four-year terms of office; and
- One (1) separate at-large seat with an abbreviated two-year term which was vacated by the person last elected to the seat.

Cudahy voters will also be presented with three (3) different tax-related ballot measures. One of the three measures is **Measure U, the 2018 Cudahy Casino Tax Measure** which poses the following question:

<b>2018 Cudahy Casino Tax Measure</b> To fund city services, including public safety and emergency services; park and street maintenance; and recreational programs, shall the City increase the license tax on casino licenses and other gambling operations to 15% percent of total monthly gross gaming revenues with a required minimum license fee of \$10,000 per month to raise a minimum of \$120,000 per year or more depending on the level of gross gaming revenues? **SYNOPSIS OF MEASURE TO BE VOTED ON:**

The Measure amends the City of Cudahy's existing tax on casino licenses and other gambling operations by establishing a 15% percent tax on total monthly gross gaming revenues with a minimum tax of \$10,000 per month. Because the tax is structured as a "general" tax within the meaning of Proposition 218, its proceeds may be used for any governmental or other public purpose, including, but not limited to, street maintenance and park maintenance, recreational programs. Precisely how much money the tax will raise will depend on the number of casino licenses that may be issued for operations in the City of Cudahy ("City") and the amount of gross gaming revenues generated by casino operations conducted in the City. It is believed that at a minimum, the tax will generate \$120,000 per year. Because the proposed tax is structured as a general tax, it must be approved by at least a simple majority (50% plus 1) of votes cast by Cudahy voters at the City's General Municipal Election of November 6, 2018.
