Staying healthy through reopening.

The City of Cudahy would like to thank everyone for abiding by CDC recommendations as parks and other locations begin to reopen. “The risk of exposure to the novel coronavirus is still out there. The opening of many states doesn’t mean COVID is decreasing, just that hospitals have capacity and the harms of shutdown outweigh the benefits,” says Daniel J. Morgan, M.D., a professor of epidemiology and public health and infectious disease at the University of Maryland School of Medicine. For this reason we must continue to follow recommended safety precautions such as wearing a mask, social distancing, and constant hand washing.

“The CDC is continuing to work with state, tribal, local, and territorial leaders to provide technical assistance, and resources that can help support decisions about how Americans begin to re-engage in civic life while adhering to mitigation strategies such as social distancing, hand-washing and wearing face coverings.” -CDC


Graffiti

Put it over your nose and mouth and secure it under your chin


Try to fit it snugly against the sides of your face

STREET SWEEPING HOURS

The City of Cudahy has lifted overnight parking restrictions until **May 3rd, 2021** no purchase of parking permits is necessary until this date.

Since **November 30th, 2020** street sweeping is now on Mondays and Tuesdays between 8:30 am and 1:30 pm on alternating sides of the streets. This means cars are to be moved on **Monday or Tuesday** between 8:30 am and 1:30 pm.

Each street side has **one** of the two days for street sweeping. This means you will always be able to park on one side of the street.

Please read signs posted at the beginning of each street for details of when vehicles should be moved for street sweeping.



Dodgers RBI Program


